If additional funding is needed students may apply, separately, for a Federal Direct Graduate PLUS or Private Alternative Loan. Applicants must be registered at least half-time to be eligible for a Federal Direct Loan (6 credits each semester during the academic year- 6 credits for each summer session). Enrollment in a degree program is required and a valid FAFSA must be on file. If your plans change at any time, it is your responsibility to notify the Office of Student Financial Services in writing. Any reduction in the number of courses taken or tuition aid received may affect your loan eligibility.
